Shading Shapes in to Forms			
Student can illustrated a gradation of value over simple shapes in pencil: sphere and cylinder.			
Student can effectively illustrate valued shifts over a shape using smooth and crosshatching shading techniques.			
Student can illustrate the illusion of form by effectively following the contour of the shape through the blending of lights and darks, varying the direction of their shading.			
Student can illustrate the direction of a light source through the inclusion and proper placement of highlight, shadow, reflected light areas and a cast shadow shape.			
Student can effectively illustrate depth and a change in surface area by including contrast /varied direction of shading between the object and the shadow (cave area) to create an illusion of form and placement on a surface.			
Student can draw a simple shape from life that through effective shading techniques illustrates all the aspects of a 3-dimensional form using smooth and crosshatching techniques.
